Home Delivery Bag Volunteer

Shifts: Tuesday and Thursday, 8:00 am - 1:30 pm (shift begins after distribution room has been setup)

Volunteer Objective

The home delivery bag helper selects groceries for homebound clients and assists with delivery. Grocery bags are made for clients who are unable to make the trip to the food bank. Some clients have specific diet and food requests which we try to accommodate when 'shopping' for them at the food bank. After packing the bags our driver and this volunteer will then drive to recipient homes and drop off groceries at their door or at reception.

Position Requirements

- Desire to help and hardworking
- Lift up to 25lb alone
- Punctual and dependable

Duties

- Pack bags, keeping dietary restrictions on bag labels in mind when 'shopping' for the recipient
- Help organize bags in van for efficient distribution
- Help hand-deliver bags to nearby apartments if necessary. Drop-off other bags in apartment complex reception areas or at the recipient's door.



After the bags have been delivered, Grocery Rescue begins which involves going to two grocery stores to pick up donations. Please refer to the "Grocery Rescue Volunteer" description for more information.
